

Lawn & Wildflower Seed Planting

1# of JJ's Blend grass seed covers 100 sq. ft.
1# of POA SUPINA grass seed covers 800 sq. ft.
It is best to sow grass seed when the ground temperature is 52 degrees or warmer.

JJ's Shade Blend great for part shade to full sun areas.

JJ's Highland Fescue Blend great for part shade lawn areas. To prevent smothering, cut mid summer to fall.

JJ's Special Blend great for full sun lawn areas (5 hours or more of sun).

Poa Supina excellent for full shade and will grow in full sun, very invasive - will take over other grasses, likes water and fertilizer. Mix 1# of poa w/ 10# of the Highland Fescue Blend at initial planting.

Germination Times:

Annual Rye: 4-10 days

Perennial Rye: 7-10 days

Fescues: 14-21 days (tolerates more drought & shade)

Bluegrass: 21-28 days (tolerates more moisture & sun)

Poa Supina: 21-28 days (tolerates full shade & acidic soil)

HOW TO PLANT WILDFLOWER SEED

1. Mix wildflower seed in a 5-gallon bucket filled with sawdust.
2. Hand toss/spread the seed where desired.
3. Slightly rake over the seed.
4. Lightly cover the seeded area with a clean straw blanket or erosion control substance.
5. Water regularly (3x per week, 30 min. per time).

NOTE: It may take up to 3 yrs. to get a full wildflower patch.

SHADE MIX (requires 2-3 hours of sun)

2 oz. – 125 sq. ft., ¼# - 250 sq. ft., 1# - 1000 sq. ft.

SUN MIX DEER RESISTANT (requires 6 hours sun)

2 oz. – 125 sq. ft., ¼# - 250 sq. ft., 1# - 1000 sq. ft.

BLACK EYED SUSAN

(yellow summer bloom, requires 6 hours of sun) 1 oz. – 2000 sq. ft.

SHASTA DAISY

(white summer bloom, requires 6 hours of sun) 1 oz. – 2000 sq. ft.

LUPINE

(blue/purple spring bloom, requires 2-3 hours of sun)

2 oz. – 130 sq. ft., ¼# - 250 sq. ft., 1# - 1000 sq. ft.

CONEFLOWER

(purple summer bloom, requires 6 hours of sun) 1 oz. – 250 sq. ft.
